Hi

I am a very concerned resident that lives at Kemps Creek which has recently been overwhelmingly taken over by the future plans to become the Aerotropolis Core for Badgerys Creek Airport.

We purchased our property 2010 knowing that we had a small amount of 1in100 land and have now been advised that you are using the PMF level to zone the south creek precinct.

In the 8 years that we have lived here we have only ever had a small amount of water at the very back of our property one time. This was due to rain for extensive periods of time over several days. This is also due to the lack of maintenance and duty of care that our local council has towards clearing and maintaining the South Creek that is at the back of our property.

I understand and accept that another Airport is required due to the expansiom and growth of our city and i am not opppsed to that. What i am opposes to is the fact that we are currently zoned RU4 now which is primary production small lots within Liverpool Council but with the new rezoning of Non-Urban that the government have introduced this will mean no new dwellings, changes or additions can be made to our properties... How can this be allowed? How is this even legal??

I am a 33 year old full time working mother with two dependants and i have worked and paid taxes since the day i turned 13 to build a life and future for my self and my family. We purchased this property for our future investment to go towards our retirement and pension but this being a proposed non urban zoning totally devalues our land which also means we wont be able to sell. So my question is how will we be able to buy and rebuild our lives and family homes??

All we ask is that we want to be treated fairly and be on an equal playing field when it comes to compensation or selling to developers as per our Aerotropolis Core neighbours.

We feel we are being sacrificed and our lives and families ripped apart for this Aerotropolis to happen which is not fair and VERY UNAustralian.

All of this has caused me and my family including my two young sons and my elderly parents who also live on the property severe anxiety and uncertainty. No one deserves to live like this. It is horrible to say the least. We need to know that the government will be fair with their zoning and buy the land fairly and equitably as we did with our hard earned money.

I plead that the government look at the zoning as this has caused anxiety and stress to myself, my family and many

residents within the area. It is not fair that the department of planning has come out to do information sessions with misinformation provided. It is also not fair that this area feels like it has been targeted especially due to over 80% of the residents being of non English speaking backgrounds, first generation Australians and over the age of 65. How are these people supposed to understand terms like 'Non-Urban' and 'Acquisition'. Most of these people have spent most of their lives breaking their back to make a buck and you feel its ok to take it all from us just like that.

If the government needs green space or non urban land we must be compensated at the same market value as the residents in the Aerotropolis Core and be treated equitably.
