My name is Aldina Serifovic of Bringelly and I am 29 years old.

In 2015, I married my husband and moved into this property with him and his parents with the intention of building our new home and start our own family once we were able to save enough money. I've lived in a suburban lifestyle all my life and was not sure what to expect by moving into a rural lifestyle that came with living in Bringelly. Upon moving to this property, I quickly realised the peacefulness and the open space that rural living offers which makes it almost unimaginable ever returning to a suburban lifestyle.

In our first year of marriage, I feel like we missed out on our â€oehoneymoon phase†and have had to sacrifice a lot in order to try and save as much money as we could so that we could finally start building our home and making our dream a reality. My husband was working 12-14 hours a day on the regular and some weeks it would feel like we would hardly see each other.

In 2017 we finally started designing our new home which cost us over 20 thousand in surveys, architectural plans, engineering plans, council fees and contributions etc. Our Development application was approved by Liverpool Council in 2018 so we are finally ready to build our new home only to be faced with these new rezoning plans. Since hearing about these plans, my husband and I find it very hard to think about anything else. We spent so long planning to build our home in this area and it now feels all our plans and hopes have gone down the drain. This is constantly playing on our minds all day every day. This has also affected my performance at work and not meeting my KPI's as I am constantly distracted with these negative thoughts and not knowing where we will end up living in the coming years. It continues when we both come home from work as this has mainly been our dinner conversation for the last few months asking ourselves whether to build or what to do and it feels like we are just going around in circles and not getting anywhere.

I understand that the new airport is coming and the infrastructure that is needed to support the airport in the surrounding areas however since hearing about the plans for Kelvin Park Drive, I feel like it has placed a dark cloud over our heads. We went from feelings of excitement and joy about starting our home and moving forward in our life to feeling constant stress and anxiety about how this is impacting our life and our now uncertain future. We are stressed about the fact that Government will be deciding how much our land is worth whereas neighbours only a few metres away will be acquiring inflated land prices from large developers. We are constantly worried that we are not going to be compensated like some of our neighbours and that that we will not be able to afford rebuilding this lifestyle in a nearby area of what we would have had here â€" 20 000 square metres of land, 2 homes, a pool, large shed and so much room for our animals.

When making these decisions, please have us in your thoughts and the impact it is going to have on our future. We just ask to be compensated fairly like the others that are in the â€oeAerotropolis Core†.
