Thank you for the opportunity for Schools Infrastructure NSW (SINSW) to provide comments on the draft Western Sydney Aerotropolis, Land Use and Infrastructure Plan, Stage: Initial Precincts (as is attached with TRIM reference number DOC18/1301624).

We have reviewed the Plan and our comments are as follows:

- As listed on pg 5, the STEM high school within the Aerotropolis Core is identified as one of the initial precincts to be delivered. Please also refer to the Vocational Educational Training (VET) facility as per the City Deal.
- In relation to the STEM school, the trigger for the delivery of the school will be the provision of supporting infrastructure including transportation for access to the school and sufficient residential development to drive demand for school places.
- As listed on pg 5, education is referenced within the Northern Gateway.
   Please clarify whether this educational facility refers to the secondary school to be provided by the Parramatta Archdiocese.
- Pg 8 'Compact urban form' include civic functions, including schools and childcare centres, with access to open space.
- As listed on pg 12, the intent of the education and training programs at the
  Aerotropolis Core will be to directly connect Western Sydney residents with
  vocational opportunities in the Aerotropolis. This will also enable residents,
  school aged and beyond, to upskill and reskill as the future of work changes
  and to respond to the demands of industries present at the Aerotropolis.
- Page 48, '6.1.2. Education' also include commentary on City Deal Commitment and investment at the Aerotropolis Core.
