We ask that our land to be included the current LUIIP and the Agriculture and Agribusiness Precinct.

We are members of the **Western Sydney Airport Agribusiness Landowner Group (WSAALG)** which is making our group submission through Think Planners. We endorse this submission and also make our own support submission on the WSA LUIIP.
