Submission: I am a holder of a Private Pilots Licence (PPL) since 1999 and trained at Warnervale Airport. As well as training I served as the treasurer of the Central Coast Aero Club from 1999 to 2001. I am also a volunteer firefighter with the NSWRFS. I am fully aware of the history of Warnervale airfield since 1972, when the Central Coast airfield was constructed by the Central Coast Aero Club. The airstrip has been an essential infrastructure that has served the military, emergency services, pilots and has offered a first class training facility. In many ways the WAR Act was rushed through without proper process and was politically motivated by the then NSW state Labor Party to save a marginal seat.
