The Director,

As a private pilot I have flown out of Warnervale Airport for some 35 years and was in fact there only last Saturday doing some circuits to refresh my cross wind landing skills. I was disappointed to hear that there is apparently some potential for the triggering of the above act with its subsequent restriction of 88 movements per day. Should this transpire it would effectively put an end to all training at Warnervale as I, along with a colleague, probably took up 44 of those movements in an hour doing those touch and goes last Saturday.

It is well known that Australia and in fact the world has an acute pilot shortage and it is relevant to note that of all commercial pilots in Australia probably 50% are generated from various aero clubs around the country.

I'd be grateful if you could give this matter further consideration as the demise of Warnervale as a training facility would be a great loss to the central coast area.
