We have lived in Ingleburn for 41 years. We have seen our region change dramatically in that time - not always for the benefit of the community.

We would like to express in very strong terms our opposition to the sale of 77 hectares of land at Hurlstone Agricultural High School.

Glenfield is a long way from Sydney CBD. There it is expected that there are high rise buildings, and some people prefer to live in that type of accommodation.

Here, though, one of the compensations for living so far out of the centre of Sydney, is the relative quietness and the "country" feel of the place.

We have endured over recent years a very large increase in population, but unfortunately the infrastructure necessary to serve our region has not followed. This will only considerably worsen if the Glenfield proposal for sale goes ahead.
