I have concerns over the safety and security of students living in a boarding school environment 24/7 surrounded by housing and shopping/industry precincts. Limiting access to school grounds will be more difficult to manage for staff and this puts students at risk. With such close proximity to the school after school hours and on the weekend when staff numbers will be vastly reduced, student safety may be compromised. How is student privacy and safety to be managed effectively? How are intruders on the site to be discouraged and how will this be managed to keep students safe?

I have concerns over the mental and physical wellbeing of students living in a boarding school who will have such limited privacy and few places to use for exercise. Loss of grounds on the school site which the students could use for free, and exclusively (thus safely) will have a negative impact of these students. How will this be managed and compensated for?
