Let me start by congratulating the authorities for taking a serious stab to transform Glenfield - a strategically located south western Sydney suburb. Well done.

While the existing plan should be appreciated, as a resident of Glenfield, I'd like to drag the attention of decision makers towards the 'Left out' areas of Glenfield beyond Canterbury Road around Glenwood Public School.

Once central Glenfield (~800m periphery of railway station) is developed the 'Left out' areas will look completely out of the place in absence of some basic infrastructure necessities such as pedestrian walk strips on the streets like Rentoul Street, Monckton pl etc.

Absence of sidewalk/pedestrians strip not only inconvenient but it's also poses risk to those who wish to walk with baby strollers.
