Should Australians be concerned? Their concerns related particularly to a \$20 million partnership between an Australian university and a major Chinese defence corporation. They're worried that the research could assist China's development of bombs, missiles, and other disruptive tech. University of New South Wales has also been accused of inappropriate transfer of information following a \$100 million partnership with multiple Chinese military entities. Scientists at Australian universities are collaborating with China's top military technology universities on programs beneficial to the People's Liberation Army which, contrary to its name, is the army of the Chinese Communist Party rather than the Chinese people, Scientists at the University of NSW and the University of Technology Sydney have worked with Yang
