I understand that the M12 is only going to be two lanes each way. If so, this is grossly inadequate and shortsighted.

A city of Sydney's size, and especially a road to an international airport requires a minimum of 4 lanes each way.

Why do we keep building 2 lane highways, when all of the equipment is there to build larger roads and economies of scale come into play.

Too often governments make this mistake because of the upfront cost involved, even though it is significantly cheaper to do it then, than to have to go back later and add lanes, often at a cost greater than that of the original road.

Two lanes each way is just a recipe for more congestion and delays on our roads. The M7 needs to be upgraded for the same reason.
