Submission: Submission re acquisition of land in Kelvin Park Drive, adjacent to Thompson's Creek. In a submission to the Stage One Plan, I indicated that we were anxious to know if our property was to be acquired; as it now seems to be the case that it will be acquired - then we would like to know when that would happen. I would suggest that - at the moment - all these properties are virtually unsalable on the private market and therefore we are disadvantaged if circumstances required us to move out in the near future. [A recent family illness has meant that this may have to be considered.] In my earlier submission I referred to two instances of minor flooding since 1998. At about 11.00 pm on the 9th February this year - following heavy rain - our entire property was flooded - with water over floor in both house and garage; part of the adjoining fences are down having been battered with debris. Liverpool council have been contacted and we have raised questions about whether local roadworks and/or blockage of Thompson's Creek was responsible. This event was entirely unexpected and it has left us feeling vulnerable to something similar in the future - as more and more infrastructure projects impact on the landscape.
