Submission: Re: Prioritisation of Precinct Planning to include Dwyer Road Precinct.

Our names are Charles & Janet Grima we are residents and [REDACTED] Bringelly. We have resided at this address for [REDACTED] years. Stage 2 of precinct planning for Aerotropolis has indicated Dwyer Road Precinct will not have priority zoning following the current exhibition period. We have been advised for Dwyer Road Precinct the timeframe for our area to be rezoned will be anything from 10-30 years.

We find this unacceptable being 3kms from a 24/7 operational airport. The dust pollution settling on our roofs can not be controlled and therefore going into our daily water supply (tank water in the Dwyer Road Precinct) Currently the road infrastructure works are creating noise & air pollution. The noise of 24/7 aircraft is a major concern.

This area for the past 45 years has been a peaceful rural area for all who live here. Previously we lived in Marrickville hence moved from there to get away from the noise & pollution of aircraft. As residents within the Dwyer Road Precinct we request urgent attention to the prioritisation of zoning our properties so that we all are given a fair and reasonable opportunity to move away from the area before the operations of a 24 Hour Airport commences.
