

What is the 'Click and Collect' Free Tree Giveaway?

The 'Click and Collect' Free Tree Giveaway is a pilot program that will provide free trees to the first 8,750 households in Greater Sydney to apply. It is part of the Greening our City Premier's Priority, which aims to plant one million trees in Greater Sydney by 2022. Planting one million trees will provide more shade, cleaner air and more beautiful places to live. To reach the one million trees target we need individuals like you to play a part and plant trees in your own backyard.

Am I eligible for a free tree(s)?

You are eligible if you answer yes to all of the following:

- you have an address in one of the 33 local government areas (LGAs) in Greater Sydney
- you have not applied for a free tree(s) since 1 July 2020.

What local government areas are eligible?

The 33 Greater Sydney LGAs:

How do I 'Click and Collect' a free tree(s)?

Free trees can be redeemed via the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment's website at: planningportal.nsw.gov.au/free-tree-give-away. You can log in with your MyServiceNSW details or create a new Planning Portal Account. Follow the instructions to select your tree(s), your preferred Bunnings store for collection and submit your application. Bunnings will contact you to collect your tree(s) when they are available in store

What trees can I order?

Eligible households may get to choose either 1 x fruit bearing tree, 1x300mm tree or 3x180-200mm trees. The list of available trees may be adjusted during the pilot, but you will be able to select from a list of trees that either:

- bear fruit
- provide privacy
- flower and provide colour

- are easy care
- provide shade.

Please note that your tree selection is subject to availability. If a tree(s) is not available a comparable tree will be substituted on your behalf.

When will my order be ready to collect from Bunnings?

After you've successfully applied and received a confirmation email, Bunnings will contact you within 15 working days to update you on the status of your order.

Are there any limits on the 'Click and Collect' Free Tree Giveaway?

Yes, including:

- trees will be made available to the first 8,750 households to apply, so get in quick and apply now
- only one order for a tree(s) per household
- once Bunnings call you to let you know your tree(s) are ready, the tree(s) must be picked up from Bunnings within 7 working days.

What do I do if I get the message "your property is not eligible for a Free Tree" but I live in one of the 33 Greater Sydney LGAs?

Please note the address field must auto-populate; we suggest that you start by typing your street name. If the address doesn't auto-populate the error message 'Your property is not eligible for a Free Tree' will appear. If the address field in the form has auto-populated and you have an eligible address, but still see this error, please email Admin_FreeTrees@dpie.nsw.gov.au

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
