A View Impact Assessment of the Western Gateway sub-precinct proposals is included in this document. The process of undertaking this analysis has included the establishment of critical views to review relative to both those that have been established within statutory planning documents and those that have been identified as important during context and site analysis.

Initial analysis has been undertaken for the Western Gateway sub-precinct Block A development. Views have been reviewed of both:

- the overall proposed planning envelope
- the reference scheme




High resolution photograph from January 2016 clearly shows disused rail siding (not in shadow). Image capture is prior to construction of Sydney Yards Access Bridge.

VIEW CORRIDORS AND SIGHT LINES

The Draft Central Sydney Planning Strategy (CSPS)includes information on a series of identified key views that are to and through parks and other well-used public spaces that have a role in defining Sydney. Views to the Central Station clock tower are sighted as an example of a significant set of views due to the clock tower's historically physical prominence in the city's landscape. Other significant views noted are along Martin Place, to and from Observatory Hill and to Sydney Harbour.

The objective stated within the document is to identify and preserve significant views from public places. Further the document notes that: "New development must be designed to make a positive contribution to the characteristics and composition of designated public views. These public views should be preserved and have priority over private views."

In addition to the views identified in the CSPS, the ¾ view as identified in the heritage analysis was included in the view analysis set.

APPENDIX B - VIEW IMPACT ANALYSIS

The sequence of view assessed in this reports includes:

- A View along Broadway
- B View across Prince Alfred Park (adjusted)
- C View along Pitt Street
- D View along Wentworth Ave at Goulburn Street
- E View along Regent Street (adjusted)
- F Three Quarter View

During the process of assessing the views it was noted that the specific position views B and E did not provide clear views of the Central Station Clock Tower. Photos from these positions have been provided adjacent to indicate the views that were found.

B - the trees at the head of Pitt St block the view so the new view used for anlysis was to the north of the trees.

E - the existing built fomr and sloping topography prevent views to the clock tower. The view utilised for the analysis was shifted to the east to correct for these issues.

Alternative positions along projections or adjacent, where clear views were possible were used of the purposes of the view assessment. These positions have been identified on the adjacent map.







The Block A envelope sits within the southern built form wall along Broadway, and is a significant visual distance from the Clock Tower.





















Currently the Central Station Clock Tower is not highly visible from this view position as it sits within the overall city skyline mass.







Showing the relationship between the Former Post Office, the Former Inwards Parcels Shed, and the West Wing of Central Station












