I am one of the registered proprietors of [REDACTED]

I have recently been advised that my property may be rezoned to Non-urban which places significant restrictions on its use and significantly reduces the value of the land.

From research it appears nothing can be done to improve it, nothing can be built or added it, not even a dog pen! In the event of a disaster (e.g. storm damage, fire, and accidental damage) my property cannot be repaired or rebuilt. At this stage I do not even know if I can get insurance on my property. It may even be illegal for the residents of the South Creek precinct to live in their own dwellings on their own properties! It is my understanding that no-one should reside on Non-urban lands, yet the State Government has said that we can stay on our land and do nothing, making us stagnant beings.

Apparently, I was never consulted about the rezoning which was restructured in 2012 and only became aware in September 2018 due to the rezoning information meeting.

I understand and support the second airport and the necessary infrastructure however I do not believe the current land owners should be penalised and further be subject to anxiety and stress.
