Dear The Director,

My name is [REDACTED] I live at [REDACTED] Kemps Creek. I have lived here since 2002 with my husband and two sons. I have recently been shown some plans regarding the future development of my area due to this I have been very concerned with the information that has been provided on the maps and plans. The reason being is because we were informed that we are future light industrial rezoning however, recently different plans have surfaced and they now state we are non-urban. I am very happy about the new airport coming to the area. However, I am worried about the future of what the change from light industrial to non-urban will have to the amount that I will be compensated for my land. I'm writing this letter for the sole purpose of requesting that I am compensated fairly. Therefore receive the same amount as my neighbours and everyone in the area whether we are classified light industrial or non-urban. I don't think its fair for people that live in the same area or street to be given different amount per acre for their land due to the fact that you decide on what to classify each property. I was always shown on plans that my land was going to be light industrial also because my property backs onto an already established light industrial factory. When we purchased this land 16years ago we were informed that we were 1 in 100 flood rating then it was changed to 1 in 20 flood rating which automatically devalued the land. We believe this change occurred so that we would not receive the fair amount for our land when the time came to sell due to the airport. As there is no reason for it to have been changed. We have not had a flood here that measures 700ml of rain continuously for three days over the whole of the Warragamba Catchment Area. The change has not been justified, there hasn't even been a slow progression it was a drastic change for no reason. Please keep in mind that I am for the airport. My main concern is that I simply am compensated the same as everyone else in the area. This has been causing me lots of stress and worry. The constant changes in information and the fact that our future is in limbo.
