I'm [redacted] at [redacted] Bringelly. I have [redacted] children and one of them is disabled. [redacted] has severe disorder called Asperger's syndrome and has had over 40 operations. [redacted] cannot stay in an enclosed area as she has daily screaming episodes. [redacted] cannot have a balanced life living on a suburban block. I am [redacted] full time carer and also look after my husband's medications for antidepressants and severe back pain medications. I have been on antidepressant tablets and struggle at times just to keep up looking after my family. [redacted] lives in hospitals most of the time. We have had fund raising to help with operations. Camden Council had a ball night in 2012 and raised money for us and bought us a new 8 seater van to be able to fit her mobilised scooter in it. [redacted] has a moderate severe hearing loss and also has a chronic blood disorder. [redacted] and my [redacted] older girls have a condition called chronic neutropenia and need to watch out of getting infections. When they get infections they also are rushed to hospital for prompt treatment. I am only [redacted] years of age and I think I have a little too much stress as it is don't you think. Now not only do I have to worry about my families health on a daily life

but now I have to worry about you putting a green belt all through our land. For [REDACTED] sake we are having an airport built at our door step and who really gives a [REDACTED] what you want to build next to it or behind it but if you think you are going to compensate us less than the house across the road you will have a fight onto the end. Not only are you trying to degrade our properties that we have struggled to pay off but you are also degrading us as human beings. The government wants it for free and then you want to sell it to the developers and make profit out of our land. I think you should come and live at my house for one day and see what families like mine really go through. The government is a disgrace and I will with my daughter [REDACTED] go on T.V and tell the world what you are trying to do to us and all our loving community. We are asking you to compensate everyone equally and fairly. Out of all of you in the government working on the development of the new air port, I know there's just one of you

that really has a heart.
If this is you and you read
my letter I only hope you
can help my family and
all of [REDACTED].

I would love to talk to you
in depth if you need more
clarification.
