Content:

Many areas of these three precincts, Northern Gateway, South Creek and Aerotropolis Core including some high lands are affected by flush flood. On the other some lands adjacent to the South Creek are high enough to never get flooded by the flush flood. Should the creek itself and it's feeder water causeways had have cleaned every 2/3 years, there would be rare possibility of getting the South Creek precincts lands to be flooded even in PMF conditions. The flood in 1 in 100 years probability can be easily mitigated and any developments including residential can be carried out without risk. Such developments are not uncommon in neighbouring areas like Edmondson Park, Leppington and Austral.

So, I propose all the lands in the three precincts of stage 1 planning to be zoned similar and such should be done before any possible acquiring of the lands by the Aerotropolis Authority. Only in such way no land owner would suffer stress and anxiety of loosing their land value.

I strongly believe that the authority would adopt this policy in its stage 1 precincts planning and in the subsequent other plannings of the Western Sydney Aerotropolis.
