I am the daughter to my parents who own this property in Bringelly, which is due to be rezoned to Non- Urban. This will cause a great loss to my family, as we have put our life savings into this property and were expecting to be compensated for the usage for our land for the development of the anthropology core. I understand that we need greenzones to balance developments, however this should not be punishing landowners who live near a proposed green spine. What we really need is equality. Even compensating landowners with a fair price that our neighbours in the aerotropolis core get would be enough to support my parents and bring financial stability back into our home. My father has not been able to work for 6 months due to receiving a heart attack in March 2018. It causes my family a large amount of stress as our income is unstable and causes many sleepless nights. Please, consider amending the problems caused by these choices. Some possible solutions include changing the flood line plans so that land within 1in 100 zones can be purchased by the government at a fair price for the use of public recreation while the 1in 1000 is zoned accordingly so it can be purchased by developers. This will bring equality back into the aerotropolis planning and will account for many of the residents wellbeing.
