Hi,

[REDACTED] And has recently been overwhelmingly taken over by the future plans to become the Aerotropolis Core for Badgerys Creek Airport.

We purchased our property in 1994 knowing that we had a small amount of 1in100 land and have now been advised that you are using the PMF level to zone the south creek precinct.

In the 24 years that we have lived here we have only ever had a small amount of water at the very back of our property one time. This was due to rain for extensive periods of time over several days. This is also due to the lack of maintenance and duty of care that our local council has towards clearing and maintaining the South Creek that is at the back of our property.

I understand and accept that another Airport is required due to the expansion and growth of our city and i am not opposed to that. What i am opposed to is the fact that we are currently zoned RU4 now which is primary production small lots within Liverpool Council but with the new rezoning of Non-Urban that the government have introduced this will mean no new dwellings, changes or additions can be made to our properties... How can this be allowed? How is this even legal??

I am a 62 year old full time parent and grand parent with two dependants and have been on a disability pension for over 10 years. Some of my children still live with me with their own families to take care of me. Prior to being diagnosed with an illness and being on a disability pension I have worked and paid taxes for over 20 years to build a life and future for my self and my children and grand children. We purchased this property for our future investment to go towards our retirement and pension and to also allow me to give a block of land eventually to all my children and grand children but this being a proposed non urban zoning totally devalues our land which also means we wont be able to sell. So my question is how will we be able to buy and rebuild our lives and family homes not just for 1 family, but the 4 families that live on the property currently!

All we ask is that we want to be treated fairly and be on an equal playing field when it comes to compensation or selling to developers as per our Aerotropolis Core neighbours.

We feel we are being sacrificed and our lives and families ripped apart for this Aerotropolis to happen which is not fair and VERY UNAustralian.

All of this has caused me and my family severe anxiety and uncertainty. No one deserves to live like this. It is horrible to say the least. We need to know that the government will be fair with their zoning and buy the land fairly and equally as we did with our hard earned money.' Most of these people have spent most of their lives breaking their back to make a buck and you feel its ok to take it all from us just like that. I ask you, how would you feel and react if you were put in this position, since these plans come to life I have not yet had a good night sleep worrying about the uncertainty of our lives and the impact it will have on my children and grand children.

If the government needs green space or non urban land we must be compensated at the same market value as the residents in the Aerotropolis Core and be treated equally.
