I am a concerned land owner from [REDACTED]

When we purchased our land in [REDACTED] we were aware of 1 in 100 floods and small part of land that is closer to the creek might be affected by floods. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] we never had any problems or floods in or around the house.

With South Creek Precinct zoning announcement, my land being in green non-urban zone is devalued and basically worth nothing. I understand that airport is coming and we have to move out, in order to get something similar in nearby suburbs we need to be compensated justly for our land. Currently our land is zoned RU4 and with recent government proposal to rezone it to non-urban green zone (probable maximum flood which is much larger than 1 in 100 flood zone), land has devalued overnight and there are no buyers for "just price".

There are no sales in [REDACTED] at the moment because of the green belt zone. Our land [REDACTED] is mainly in green zone and small part of land is flexible employment/urban land (Aerotropolis core).

I would like to know what is going to happen with our land. If government needs our land as green space or other purpose we are expecting to be compensated at just and same market value as other land owners in the Aerotropolis Core.
