As I am aware that you would be inundated with submissions I must tell you that since these maps of the South Creek Precinct has come to life our lives have changed dramatically from not sleeping to stressing to arguing as we are unaware of our future [REDACTED]

We purchased our property 2005 knowing that we had a small amount of 1in100 land and have now been advised that you are using the PMF (probable Maximum Flood) level to zone the south creek precinct and even find this unusual as we have never been inundated with water but believe if Councils maintained the South Creek we would not even have 1in100 flood line...

I understand and accept that another Airport is required and am not opposed to that, what I am opposed to is the fact that we are currently zoned RU4 now which is primary production small lots within Liverpool Council but with the new rezoning of Non-Urban (green spine) that the government has introduced us to, we are now in limbo and frozen in time.

We have built a beautiful family here in [REDACTED] with my 2 children and couldn't ask for a better life but I am well aware that we will have to move from our address for you to continue with your vision, all I ask is that the Government should be fair and pay equally after they rezone our properties as I believe that the South Creek precinct is being sacrificed for your vision and we will be left in ruins.

All of this has caused me and my family severe anxiety and stress and I have not been the same person since these plans came to life and to add to this stress I also am dealing with cancer in the family and now cannot put my 100% into this as all I am thinking of are these maps. No one deserves to live like this. We have spent most of our lives breaking our backs to make ourselves a future in buying land hoping one day this will be our super and pensions and to be thrown in an Environmental zone is just unacceptable. I ask u, how would you feel and react if you were put in this position.

We ask that land sitting in medium and low flood plains should be returned to ourselves as we then can on sell to developers and be on par with Aerotropolis Core residents, however if extra land is required by Government bodies for recreational or parklands, south creek rejuvenation, cycle ways etc. these lands

should be purchased by these bodies at the same value of the Aerotropolis Core after re-zoning.

We hope that they do the right thing by all these residents that are affected and not have a repeat of the mid-north coast saga as we know you are playing with our future...

This truly will impact over 68 of my neighbors as most of us are elderly or coming into retirement age so we ask you do the right thing.
