Submission: The plan talks about the significance of the Razorback/ Burratorang wildlife corridor, yet proposes to have the M9 Orbital cutting through the wildlife corridor between Cawdor/ Elizabeth Macarthur Ag Institute and Razorback. Please extend the Camden M9 Orbital tunnel an additional 4-5 kilometers further south to allow for this important wildlife corridor between Cawdor/ Menangle/ Razorback to be preserved. I support the tunnelling of the M9 Orbital under May Farm road at Cobbitty/ Brownlow Hill to preserve the Cobbitty Hills and homes along that ridge, but the tunnel needs to be extended further at the Southern end to preserve the wildlife corridor at Razorback.
