Submission: The Razorback region has important threatened wildlife such as the koala, cumberland land snail and black cockatoo. The Razorback area extends to the East to Camden Park, as noted in the report. The M9 Orbital is proposed to cut through this important conservation area. Please extend the M9 tunnel at Camden further to the south to avoid the 8 lane freeway and freight rail line cutting through the Razorback and Cawdor region. Please preserve this important wildlife corridor between Camden Park and the Razorback range by extending the Camden M9 orbital tunnel by 4 kms at the southern end
