Request for Lot [REDACTED] should be excluded from the Cumberland Plain Conservation Plan (CPCP)

The following information is provided to support the exclusion;

The creek shown running through the Lot is no more than a open stormwater drain that takes excess stormwater from the Defence Department site (located south of the Lot), The Northern Road's rainwater run off and overflow from the Orchard Hills Water Filtration Plant.

Plants on the Lot have been planted and or not naturally established.

The Lot is sandwiched between very busy multi lane major road and residential land

The Lot is private property and not accessible open and green spaces.

The Lot cannot be accessed or enjoyed by the community.

The Lot is used for grazing of domestic animals and storage of Plant and Equipment.

If it is your decision to include this Lot or part thereof, in the (CPCP) the Lot's usefulness, current and future value will be greatly reduced.

I also wish to point out my disappointment regarding the preparation of this Draft (CPCP) without engagement of stakeholder.
