Submission: The draft plan should be rejected. My key concerns follow: - fast track process that removes the capacity for communities to comment; - the development of rural land as far SW as Wilton; - the impact on Critically Endangered Ecological Community under both NSW and Commonwealth status; - the impact on koala colonies; - the failure to accept all the recommendations from Chief Scientist, - the failure to acknowledge rural landscapes; and - the impact on urban heat, particularly in view of the escalation in climate change. I am deeply concerned about the Plan and believe the draft in its current form is not in the public interest.
