Submission: The draft plan seriously detracts from the Greater Sydney Commission's mandate for the Western Parkland City as it will destroy over 1000 hectares of irreplaceable woodlands and threaten already endangered flora and fauna such as the koala and glossy black cockatoo. The Plan should be amended to include the following: 1. Prohibit developers from using any public land as offsets. 2. Preserve all critically endangered Cumberland Plain woodlands. 3. Protect the Cumberland Conservation Corridor. 4. Provide an adequate wildlife corridor at Mount Gilead/ Figtree Hill. 5. Protect Wianamatta Regional Park. 6. Preserve the wildlife corridor between the Elizabeth Macarthur Agricultural Institute and Razorback, Cobbitty Hills and existing housing.
