Submission: The draft Cumberland plan needs to also include more wildlife corridors and also replant enormous areas of land. The Sydney basin is an urban heat island and this is making it more prone to bushfires and droughts. The Driftway in Londonderry on the Hawkesbury University of Western Sydney grounds has remanent Cumberland plain areas that are listed on the national estate register of national significance but are not included in your plan. This is an important wildlife corridor. How can this area not be included and it just seems to be ignored. This same area is an aboriginal trail site. This reinforces its significance. It is also located between the Windsor downs nature reserve and Agnes banks nature reserve. Native habitat needs to be more strongly protected as well and residents should be supported in replanting their rural land as usually its the opposite. Residents are clearing more and more remnant Cumberland plain destroying habitat for the wildlife.
