1. When you say there won't be planning controls on LALC land, can this land be used for biodiversity opportunities – opportunities to work with LALCs if they are interested in biodiversity opportunities. Working with BCT to work on potential sites and initial set ups
2. When you say no planning controls with land under claim in the Plan area. What is the monitoring process when claims are resolved, or new ones made? What if claims were applied or requested after the Plan rezones land?
3. DPIE commented that if they know in advance about upcoming claims it would be easier to not apply the zoning now rather than later?
4. Can you follow up with your land claims unit was is likely to come under claim so not to implement the zoning?
5. Sharon: When you say joint management to you mean under the act where lands are returned to LALCs or joint management under the act or informal co management with NPWS – can you find out more?
6. Abe: Access to conservation land - What about community that are still practicing ceremony – and looking to increase it in the area? Looking to establish connection to country in Western Sydney
