**Re: Submission to Draft Cumberland Plain Conservation Plan – Strongly Object.**

Dear Mr. Hartley & Ms. Irwin,

Firstly, thank you for giving me the opportunity to write this letter.

I will start with my disappointment with the NSW Department of Planning for not including me or sending me a letter apparently dated on 26 August & 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2020 advising which properties are affected for the environmental conservation (E2) zoning and Riparian corridors. One would presume we are not affected being the owners of 88 Muscatel Way Orchard Hills NSW 2748.

As quite several neighbors within our **strong** community are affected, we have no choice but to **Strongly Object** to any or my property (If affected) and neighbors to the proposed E2 Zoning and Riparian corridors.

Reviewing the Biodiversity Act., Land & Environmental Acts and Water Management Act, I do not see any reasoning for our land to be rezoned.

The NSW State Planning Department have **failed** to notify me with a draft conservation plan or deadline for submission dated 26 August 2020. Furthermore, **no** onsite assessment and community consultation occurred.

If on the rare occasion of excessive storm water run-off are due to lack of road guttering/drainage systems and several man-made dams that I do not believe are approved. Therefore, why should we be punished?

To date I only have been notified and advised by neighboring properties and support from our Member of Parliament (MP) Ms. Tanya Davies.
