Dear Sir/Madam,

I am a landowner affected by the proposed rezoning in the draft recommendations.

These new proposals for rezoning to E2 were previously zoned in the Wilton 2040 plan as RU2. Why has this been changed?

I have had no consultation on these changes and would certainly oppose them. I have lived in Wilton for the past 30 years and have diligently maintained the flora and fauna. When I bought the property it was derelict, full of weeds, old cars, buses, rusting machinery etc. It took me hundreds of trips to the tip and untold hours of back breaking work to restore the property. I have fought drought, bushfires and the uncertainty of Covid 19, I don't need this!

I received correspondence from Planning Industry and Environment 26th August 2020, in which I was informed my land was within the area proposed for environment conservation E2 zoning. I rang the Department to get further information on the phone number provided. I was told to email biodiversity@planning.nsw.gov.au, which I did on the 18/9/20 and have had no reply to date. I went to the public exhibition of the draft when I had trouble with the website, and was handed a booklet with writing so small it was near impossible for me to read or make out the zoning etc.

I strongly oppose the unfair rezoning and ask the Department to leave the zoning as is.
