When we purchased the land 18 years ago, our land had not a shrub or tree. We then applied for approval to erect a shed, Penrith Council will have photos of our land with not a tree or shrub. Penrith Council granted permission to erect the shed on our property, Penrith Council then required landscaping after the shed was constructed, but everything we planted did not survive.

In 2009 we purchased a gum tree from bunnings and planted it, and this is the tree that you have identified as part of the Cumberland Plan.

We have photos from google earth going back to 2002 to 2009 showing no tree, we have attached photos from 2002 to 2009 showing no tree (The tree on our land is not a tree from Cumberland Plan).

The trees that you are wanting to protect are on both sides of Mamre Road & Luddenham Road which both roads will be widened, but that's ok to destroy hundreds of the Cumberland Forest trees to accommodate Badgerys Creek Airport. But you need to save <u>one</u> Bunnings bought tree on our land.

In the past the councils controlled what trees were protected, so why do we need another government department to make the decision the council makes every day. (another waste of tax payers money.)

We have paid exorbitant land rates & land taxes for the past 18 years we should be compensated for the devaluation of our land, you are destroying our livelihood & our retirement.
