

The following need to be incorporated into the SEPP

1. Traditional Custodians should provide assessments, be involved in certification and monitoring during construction

2. Local knowledge - land, water, sea, weather, climate etc should be an educational requirement for certified urban planners.

3, energy use for operation of buildings and individual dwellings should be assessed - this should include transport, washing, cooling, heating, lifts, cooking, refrigeraion, hot water, sourcing food, waste...

*hot water systems need to be designed for minimal water use - not running taps and showers wait for hot water

*land and access needs to be allocated for mature trees to grow and be managed

*urban forest management including use of timber/mulch
