A number of grass feeding parrot species inhabit the area for the proposed site. It is critical that this grassland is recognised as a critical habitat for endangered native species and maintained with appropriate fire and conservation activities to ensure the survival after this otherwise destructive precinct is rolled out.

Native trees that encourage bats, black cockatoos, gang gangs and other rare Australian native birds should be maintained and planted to facilitate biodiversity rather than another pigeon and rat filled city such as Sydney or Parramatta.

The majority of people may not be aware enough about this issue to care, but please listen to the ecologists, scientists and conservation groups who have intimate knowledge of these requirements.
