Hello,

My family own [redacted], [redacted] Thomas Laycock Place, Bringelly. Back in September it was rezoned as 'Mixed Use'. However, subsequent to the rezoning, the Initial Draft Plan came out allocating our property as 'Urban Park' space.

To my understanding, our property/land has the following feature:

- 1 - it is NOT flood affected land, being on high elevation,
- 2 - it contains NO native or significant vegetations on the land, and
- 3. it contains NO native animal or habitats of any significance.
