The new roads that you have in the Aerotropolis are too narrow. Look at the Bringelly Road/Jersey Road intersection on the southern boundary for example. There are currently provisions for a 4 lane (2 lane each way) carriageway yet the draft Aerotropolis Plan only has a single lane slip lane. This is grossly insufficient particularly for an intersection on such a main arterial road as Bringelly Road. Not to mention the future Jersey Road extension proposed to Oran Park. It will create a traffic bottleneck in its current form and must be addressed immediately.
