


INCAPI-372	<p><b>Online DA - Ability for Council users to Resend the Application from workflow (via logging in to the Portal) and API</b></p> <p>Following Vendors feedback, a new enhancement is planned in the Portal to allow councils to request for the application details to be re-sent via API from ePlanning to Council systems using the options below:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>1. By logging in to the Planning Portal:</b> When operating from a Development Application in the Portal, a new <b>Action</b> “Resend API” is made available. This allow council user to resend the application details from the Portal to council system.</li> </ol> <p>See the screen shots below.</p>   <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>2. Via API -</b> Council system can send the <b>GetCaseInfo</b> API request to ePlanning which will trigger a <b>CreateDA</b> API from the Portal to Council System. <p>INCAPI-371</p>	<p><b>ePlanning Certificate APIs - Simplify &amp; Standardise updatedBy API Block</b></p> <p><b>Note: Online DA APIs are not impacted by the following changes.</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. In all Certificate Registration, Post-consent and CDC <b>inbound APIs to ePlanning</b> the updatedBy block, which currently takes the full Person Object, has been simplified to accept “updatedByEmail” only. This will help to allow only registered &amp; authorised council users to raise the API requests and prevent the need to provide the information previously submitted to the Portal which reduces the unnecessary validation around “person” details.</li> <li>2. From the following outbound API calls from ePlanning to council/certifier systems, the “surname” attribute of the Person Object has been updated to “familyName” to standardise this attribute naming. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Post-consent Certificate API – Withdraw, UploadPractitionerDocuments, UpdateAdditionalInfo,</li> </ul> </li> </ol>	<p>Online Certificate Registration, Online Post-consent Certificate, Online CDC APIs</p>
