Environmental Planning and Assessment (COVID-19 Development—Construction Work Days) Order (No 1) 2021

I, Rob Stokes, the Minister for Planning and Public Spaces, make the following Order under section 10.17 of the Act.

I am satisfied the Existing Order is no longer necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of members of the public during the COVID-19 pandemic, and that construction work days and hours can be returned to their pre-pandemic settings. I have also consulted with the Minister for Health and Medical Research in relation to the making of this Order.

Note. The power to make an order under section 10.17 of the Act includes the power to revoke the order as provided by section 1.4(8) of the Act.

1 Name of Order

This Order is the Environmental Planning and Assessment (COVID-19 Development—Construction Work Days) Order (No 1) 2021.

2 Commencement

This Order commences 14 days after it is published in the Gazette.

3 Definitions

(1) In this Order—

the Act means the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979.

Existing Order means the Environmental Planning and Assessment (COVID-19 Development – Construction Work Days) Order 2020 dated 31 March 2020 and published in Gazette No 68 on 2 April 2020.

Note. The Act and the *Interpretation Act 1987* contain definitions and other provisions that affect the interpretation and application of this Order.

(2) Notes included in this Order do not form part of this Order.

4 Construction work days

The Existing Order is revoked.
