

# Environmental Planning and Assessment (COVID-19 Development—Construction Work Days) Order (No 1) 2021

I, Rob Stokes, the Minister for Planning and Public Spaces, make the following Order under section 10.17 of the Act.

I am satisfied the Existing Order is no longer necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of members of the public during the COVID-19 pandemic, and that construction work days and hours can be returned to their pre-pandemic settings. I have also consulted with the Minister for Health and Medical Research in relation to the making of this Order.

**Note.** The power to make an order under section 10.17 of the Act includes the power to revoke the order as provided by section 1.4(8) of the Act.

## 1 Name of Order

This Order is the *Environmental Planning and Assessment (COVID-19 Development—Construction Work Days) Order (No 1) 2021*.

## 2 Commencement

This Order commences 14 days after it is published in the Gazette.

## 3 Definitions

(1) In this Order—

**the Act** means the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.


**Existing Order** means the *Environmental Planning and Assessment (COVID-19 Development – Construction Work Days) Order 2020* dated 31 March 2020 and published in Gazette No 68 on 2 April 2020.

**Note.** The Act and the *Interpretation Act 1987* contain definitions and other provisions that affect the interpretation and application of this Order.

(2) Notes included in this Order do not form part of this Order.

## 4 Construction work days

The Existing Order is revoked.
